- Your child would like Medicaid and your household earns between <u>185-300% of the Federal</u>
 Poverty Guidelines –OR–
- Your child already has Medicaid and you would like to access respite services paid by Medicaid

Note: A youth is not required to go to the Independent Assessor unless applying for Medicaid with a household income between 185-300% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, or the youth needs access to Medicaid paid respite.
